# DAY 3

- Transfer via motorcoaches to Pearl Harbor | Today you will visit the
  USS Arizona Memorial and will have the opportunity to raise your
  school's American flag aboard the Memorial (pending acceptance
  by the Parks Department), before taking the short trip to Ford
  Island.
- While on Ford Island, you will perform at the Battleship Missouri Memorial (pending acceptance by the Parks Department), have an included lunch and time to tour the Battleship. Pearl Harbor is one of Oahu's most-visited attractions and is a legacy of its World War II history. Operated by the National Park Service, the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor commemorates the U.S. Navy and Marine personnel who died in the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. Your visit includes the viewing of a 22-minute historical film and a ranger-guided boat trip to the 184-foot memorial, Arizona.

# DAY 4

- Meet the motor coaches for a full day touring the Island of Oahu.
